CORONAVIRUS UPDATE

INFORMATION FROM THE SPEECH AND LANGUAGE THERAPY SERVICE

Dear Parents / Guardians

As you will be aware many NHS services are currently disrupted due to the Coronavirus (Covid-19) outbreak.

Many of our appointments and therapy sessions take place on school based premises. We have made the decision to not see children and young people in Special Educational Needs Schools following advice from the Department of Health who are advising those who are at increased risk of severe illness from coronavirus (COVID-19) to be particularly stringent in following social distancing measures and this includes patients with a learning disability.

Please be reassured, if your child was receiving a block of therapy that is no longer able to go ahead, the member of our team who was working with your child will be in touch with you to discuss how you can support their targets at this time.

If your child was due to have a review in the next few months, we may telephone you to discuss their progress instead. If you have had any changes to your contact details please let the department know either on the above telephone number of the email below.

We may offer home visits where possible and in accordance with stringent guidelines to best protect our most vulnerable children. If parents would prefer us not visit please let us know.

If you have any concerns or questions about your child's speech and language therapy, or you would like some resources sent electronically to support your child please get in touch with on via <u>STCCG.speechtherapy@nhs.net</u>. Please include your child's name and date of birth so we can access their patient records.
