They have been assessed Using Yoga Bugs Performance Review Impact and Change Programme in the following areas - social, emotional, physical, behavioural and PSHE. Staff have reported children have settled well into the familiar routine and making yoga positions with greater ease and some even independently!</p> <p>Pupils in year 5/6 have worked towards their Gymnastics Level 1 and Level 2 awards. Students will perform their routines for parents in the summer term.</p> <p>Y5/6 pupils have recently started working with Evolve Karate Company. Each child has a star chart where each week they are aiming to be awarded a star for skills such as teamwork, respect, self - control, confidence, focus, effort and sportsmanship.
