## How to make a bird feeder

## What you will need:

- A plastic bottle
- 2 pencils, or wooden skewers/dowels
- Scissors
- A screwdriver
- String/twine
- A funnel
- Bird seed or cereal/oats

Clean the bottle and remove the wrapper.

You may need an adult to help you when using the screwdriver and scissors. With the screwdriver pierce a hole approx. 1 inch from the bottom into the side of the bottle.

Make another hole opposite and place pencil or skewer through the two holes. Repeat this again on the opposite side 2 inches higher up. This will be for the birds to sit on.

Using the screwdriver again make another hole above your pencils/skewers and the use the scissors to make it bigger (about the size of your finger). This is for the birds to get the food out. Repeat on the opposite side.

Remove the lid and put a hole in using the screwdriver. Put the string through the hole and tie a couple of knots.

Put the funnel into the top of the bottle and pour your seed/cereal in.

Fasten the lid back on and your bird feeder is ready to hang up outside.
