You can start by recycling as much of the rubbish that you throw away at home or at school, we all should have recycling boxes, bags or bins. The rubbish that goes in these is recycled to be used again.

Recycled plastics are used to create all sorts of items, such as packaging, bags, car parts, furniture, building material and paint pots.

Recycled glass can be used to make new jars and bottles, jewellery beads, glass tiles for your bathroom or kitchen and is even made into loft insulation, to keep your house warm and save energy.

Recycled metal can not only be remade into new tin cans, but also made into car parts, bikes, bed frames and matress springs and even aeroplane and space rocket parts!

So instead of polluting the environment even more and using dangerous chemicals to make new items, it is much cleaner and less dangerous to recycle our waste.
